Business car classic is coming to China, with Portuguese entrepreneurs behind the wheel

A Portuguese company car classic will present part of their collection in Shanghai next week, trying to open a business area still rare in China, but likely to attract portfolio of new-rich sites.

The presentation, organized in collaboration with an international brand of luxury goods, held at a private club after the rally of classic cars Beijing-Shanghai, featuring the participation of two Portuguese teams.

"In the last decade, the value of classic cars approached the 400% and this component is especially striking in China," said Azeredo Lusa Jean Leblanc, president of Exclusive Classic Cars (ECC) and pilot replica Jaguar C, 1982, entering at that rally.
